**ADMINISTRATIVE LETTER 1981-6**

TO: Automobile Clubs Licensed to Transact Business in Virginia


RE: 1981 Legislation - Effective July 1, 1981  
(Reimbursement to Members for Expense Incurred  
for Emergency Road Service or Towing Service)

Section 13.1-400.1 of the Code of Virginia was amended by act of the General Assembly during its 1981 Session to eliminate the \$25 limit on the reimbursement of automobile club members for their expense incurred for emergency road service or for towing service.

The amended statute permits the issuance of automobile club service contracts with dollar limits in whatever amount is mutually agreeable to the automobile club and the applicant/member.

A copy of Senate Bill 499 (Chapter 10) effecting this change is on the reverse side of this letter.
