

MORTGAGE LENDER/BROKER LICENSE AND BRANCH RENEWAL FOR 2012

The Nationwide Mortgage Licensing System ("NMLS") requires licensees to renew their mortgage lender/broker license and the license of each separate branch office by the end of each calendar year. Although Virginia law does not require such renewal, failure to renew the licenses through NMLS, will distort the NMLS records of the licensees. Requests for renewal can be submitted to NMLS beginning November 1, 2011 to December 31, 2011. You are urged to submit your renewal request by December 15, 2011, in order to receive approval by the end of the calendar year.
