

Due to the ongoing pandemic of COVID-19, it is important for our delegation to add to our concerns over the proposed rate increase by Old Dominion Power Company, a division of Kentucky Utilities Company. In addition to our letter from October 3, 2019, which addressed concerns over a company's bankruptcy that affected hundreds of families in Southwest Virginia, we ask that the State Corporation Commission note our concerns regarding COVID-19's affect on families and businesses throughout Old Dominion Power Company's service territory.

COVID-19 has caused a record number of Virginians to file for unemployment. Additionally, government mandated closures have also contributed to the loss of revenue for numerous businesses in our area.

Much like our letter from October 3, 2019, we ask that the State Corporation Commission seriously consider the adverse effects that this proposed increase will have on families, businesses, and public/private institutions.
