APPLICATION OF NATIONAL COUNCIL ON COMPENSATION INSURANCE

ORDER APPROVING APPLICATION OF THE NATIONAL COUNCIL ON COMPENSATION INSURANCE FOR REVISIONS TO THE MANUAL OF RULES, CLASSIFICATIONS AND RATES FOR WRITING WORKERS' COMPENSATION INSURANCE IN THE COMMONWEALTH

BY CORRESPONDENCE DATED May 15, 2020 came National Council on Compensation Insurance on behalf of its members and filed proposing to establish Experience Rating Plan and Statistical Plan rules for reporting claims with a catastrophe event code and exclude from experience rating calculations such losses attributable to the COVID 19 pandemic with and requested the approval of the Commissioner of Insurance of certain revisions to the Manual of Rules, Classifications and Rates for writing Workers' Compensation Insurance in this Commonwealth, to wit:

Item Filing E-1407 Exclusion of COVID-19 Claims from Experience Rating and Merit Rating

NOW ON THIS DAY the Commissioner, having considered the recommendations of the staff of the Bureau of Insurance is of the opinion, finds and orders:

(1) That the proposed revisions in this filing to the Manual of Rules, Classifications and Rates for writing workers' compensation insurance in this Commonwealth will not produce rates which are excessive, inadequate, or unfairly discriminatory, and should be, and they hereby are, approved for use in this Commonwealth when calculating experience modification factors with rating effective dates of August 16, 2020 and later

(2) THAT AN ATTESTED copy hereof shall be sent to the National Council on Compensation Insurance; to the Virginia Workers' Compensation Commission; and, to Rebecca Nichols, Deputy Commissioner of Insurance.
