Equipment Information:

(All audio can be heard through the courtroom sound system. All video content is displayed on the large projector screen, LED monitors and flat screen TVs)

Digital audio recording	Record hearings/meetings. Final audio can be downloaded onto a laptop or thumb drive. Audio can also be saved to a CD or DVD.
Audio teleconferencing	Calls can be heard through the audio system in the courtrooms. Ideal for: Conferencing in parties physically unable to attend a meeting/hearing
Wireless hearing assistance headsets	Headsets for those hard of hearing.
Document camera	Display hard copies of documents, one page at a time. Very easy to use. <i>Ideal for: Displaying a hard copy of a document (separate pages) or photos</i>
Blu-ray player	Displays visual content on DVDs and plays audio CDs.
HDMI/VGA laptop connections	View or listen to any content from a laptop. You must use your own personal laptop. SCC laptops are for employee use only.
